#### **A. Adoption of the City of Guyton millage rate**


Mayor Lariscy took a moment to explain to those in attendance the 2018 tax digest and five (5) year history. The City is moving to adopt the rollback millage rate of 2.665. Councilman Collins made a motion to adopt the 2.665 rollback millage rate, seconded by Councilman Goldwire. Motion carried.

#### **B. Consideration and discussion regarding phase two in the Summer Place subdivision and a letter of credit**

Mayor Lariscy stated that during the recent storms, areas in Summer Place had three (3) feet of water. There are drainage issues that need to be corrected. Councilman Collins recommended issuing a letter of credit to the developer to ensure the work was completed correctly. After some discussion, Mayor Lariscy asked for a motion authorizing Mr. Wirth to work with Wesley Parker, the City Engineer, to develop a money figure to require on the letter. Said motion was made by Councilman Lee, seconded by Councilman Johnson. The motion carried.

Councilman Goldwire made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilman Johnson. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
