## **Request for Proposals: Resurfacing an outdoor basketball court**

### **Location:**

Highland Park – Hwy 17 (between Anderson Ave & Samuel Smalls Sr Ave);  
Parcel ID# G0060001

### **Scope of Work:**

This project generally consists of resurfacing an outdoor basketball court in a City owned park.

- Remove existing eroded surface;
- Resurface 40' x 90' area with asphalt or comparable material;
- Coat surface with basketball court grade paint;
- Paint lines consistent with college level basketball court specifications.

Increased consideration will be given to proposals with innovative designs and expediate completion time frames. A fence may have to be removed to complete job, however, proposal shall uninstalling and reinstalling any fence that is manipulated.

### **Bid Requirements:**

Bids must be received no later than 4:30 PM on August 1, 2019. Bid Packets are available at City Hall, on the website at [www.cityofguyton.com](http://www.cityofguyton.com), and can be made available via email upon request. All bidders are required to be insured/bonded as prescribed by law, and provide certificate of insurance covering Workman's Compensation, Occupational Disease, Employer's Liability, and General Liability with the submitted packet.

Please preface your proposal with a brief history of your firms work with municipal governments and constructing similar projects.

Bid submittals will be opened at a Special Called Council Meeting at a date to be determined by City Council. The Special Called Meeting will be held in city council chambers at City Hall located at 310 Central Boulevard, Guyton, Georgia. Applicants will be notified of meeting date/time.

The City reserves the right to obtain clarification of any point in a proposer's proposal or to obtain additional information necessary to properly evaluate a particular proposal. Failure of a proposer to respond to such a request for additional information or clarification may result in rejection of the proposer's proposal.

The City of Guyton and its representatives shall be the sole judge of the bidder's ability to meet the requirements set forth. The City's decision in determining the winning responsible bidder will be final.

The City reserves the right to act in its best interest in this determination process, to waive all technicalities, to select the winning bidder, and to reject any and all other bids.
