# Guyton Downtown Development Authority's Strategic Planning Committee (SPC) Report February 19, 2025

During the SPC meeting on 02/12/2025, we focused on finalizing a final list of short and long term goals for the DDA Board to consider moving towards. The SPC Committee asks that the DDA Board gives us feedback and suggestions regarding the following goals.

#### **Short-Term Strategic Plans (1-3 years)**

- Commission painting of mural on the conner of Central Ave. and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street
- Install landscaping planters in front of business between Lynn Bonds Ave. and 4<sup>th</sup> Street
- Food Truck Fridays (once a quarter)
- Downtown Business Mixer (twice a year)
- Develop a list of the types of business we want in the downtown district
- Develop relationships with real estate developers to help develop the downtown district
- Look and apply for grants to help fund projects for the downtown district

## **Long-Term Strategic Plans (5-10 years)**

- Redesign the Guyton Walking Trail as a walking history trail all along the trail install signs/planforms that display historical facts about Guyton, Effingham Co., and Georgia
- Incorporate curbs, sidewalks, and additional lighting throughout downtown
