Please read the following information and sign below including the address of the driveway that you want inspected. The Inspector will go out and look at the driveway to determine what it will require. If you are required to put a culvert down, it should be reinforced concrete and a minimum of 24 feet in length. The joints of the pipe shall be wrapped with geo textile material (filter fabric) and have the gaskets installed on all the joints. The inspector will determine the pipe diameter of each separate location. Once it is installed, a re-inspection will be required before it is covered.
