City of Guyton 2022 Christmas Parade Registration

On Saturday, December 3, 2022, the City of Guyton will host the Annual Christmas Parade. The parade will start at Guyton Elementary School and end at the Public Safety Complex. The parade will start at Guyton Elementary School, turn right onto Highway 17, turn left onto Lynn Bonds Avenue, turn left onto Church Street, and stop at the Department of Public Safety Complex at Church Street and Fifth Avenue. Our goal is to have a spectacular and safe event. Please review and abide the Parade Rules and Regulations posted on the City of Guyton website at www.cityofguyton.com. Judging will begin promptly at 10am and the parade will begin at 11am. You may start arriving at 7:30am but should arrive no later than 9am. Please be prompt in your arrival out of consideration for the parade organizers and time restrictions. You must sign-in upon arrival.

PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS KEEP THIS FORM FOR YOUR RECORDS

- Parade participants will arrive at the Guyton Elementary School Grounds at the **side entrance on Cemetery Street**. If you have not sent in your registration for by the due date, your entry will be moved to the end of the parade.
- The Guyton Elementary School Grounds will be open at 7:30am. Arrival no later than 9am is advised. Judging will begin at 10am followed by the parade kick-off promptly at 11am.
- Each entry will be given a number prior to the parade date that you should have displayed visibly on your float. This will mark your position in the parade.
- It would be best if the entire group arrived together to avoid confusion.
- No alcohol or smoking is permitted.
- If you are passing out candy or such, please refrain from throwing it into the street. This is to protect the children and others from running into the streets to collect it. It will also prevent people from being hit with the candy.
- No marring the street (skid marks) from tires is allowed.
- If you have animals, you are responsible for cleaning up after them for the duration of the event. **All animals must wear a catch apron.** Participants will also provide an attendant to following the group with a scoop and collection bin to gather any animal waste immediately, should the need arise. This applies on the school grounds and along the parade route.
- **DO NOT HAVE SANTA ON YOUR FLOAT.** There will be one (1) Santa in the parade. He will be the Fire Department entry.
- There will be parking at Guyton Elementary School for parade participants.
- The parade will start at Guyton Elementary School, turn right onto Highway 17, turn left onto Lynn Bonds Avenue, turn left onto Church Street, and stop at the Department of Public Safety property located at Church Street and Fifth Avenue. You will not be permitted to leave the parade route before this point.
- To continue back to the school, the route is to continue on Church Street, turn left onto Seventh Avenue, turn right onto Highway 17, and turn left into the school parking lot. Following these regulations are for the safety of the parade participants. We will have police presence maintaining road closures.
