Summary	The City of Guyton has an immediate opening for the position of Streets & Lanes Laborer/Equipment Operator. This position is responsible for operating a variety of light and heavy machinery and equipment, assisting with construction and daily maintenance, and upkeep of the city streets and lanes infrastructure.		
Employee Expectations	All team members of the City of Guyton Maintenance Department are expected to work diligently and collaboratively in furthering the goals and objectives that serve the City of Guyton and its residents, businesses, and guests.		
Minimum Qualifications	 High School diploma or GED required Minimum three (3) years relevant experience in a road construction or maintenance position required. Experience with and knowledge of local road construction/maintenance codes and ordinances required. Must have experience with operating earth-moving equipment Must have experience with proper ditching and pipe-laying procedures. Knowledge of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Device standards as it applies to work zone safety is preferred. Experience with and knowledge of operating a dump truck is preferred. Demonstrate knowledge and experience with operating various hand and power tools, and tools and equipment used for ditch and pipe-laying work required. Must have skill in performing preventative maintenance on both light and heavy equipment. Must have good communication skills, both oral and written; must possess good interpersonal skills; or any combination of education, training, or experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills, and abilities for the position.
